

AFG Group Classes & Tutoring Policies

Group Classes

Schedules:

- Adult Group Classes are offered in trimesters of 11 weeks each: Fall (September-December), Winter (January-March), and Spring (April-June). A variable summer session is offered based on demand at a prorated rate.
- After-School Classes are offered in trimesters of 11 weeks each: Fall (September-December), Winter (January-March), and Spring (April-June).
- Ecole du Samedi is offered for the full school year: September to June, 3 Saturdays each month. An “Early Bird Discount” is available to those who enroll their child before the end of August. Parents may pay tuition in two installments: one before each semester (before September and before January).
- Summer Camp is offered for several weeks each summer.

Adults are grouped according to their level of French and their personal learning goals and preferred pace. For all but total beginners, we recommend taking our placement test to assess the most appropriate level.

Registration payments must be processed before the class begins.

The AFG does not issue refunds after the first class, but can apply credit toward another AFG class or program.

Classes canceled by the teacher will be made up at the end of the session or at another time that is mutually agreed upon by the teacher and students.

Students will not be reimbursed for classes missed, nor can the AFG schedule make-up classes for individual students' absences. If you need to miss a class, please give the teacher 24 hours' notice and they will send you materials to complete at home.

If a student joins a class late in the session, a prorated rate may be charged for the remainder of the session. The above policy regarding absences applies to all students, whether they have enrolled in the full session or part of a session.

All children must be toilet trained before they start classes.

Tutoring

Payments must be processed before lessons begin.

The AFG does not issue refunds after the first lesson, but can apply credit toward another AFG class or program.

Cancellations of in-person lessons must be arranged 24 hours ahead of time. If the teacher is not given 24 hours' notice, the student(s) will be charged for the lesson. Cancellations of online lessons must be

arranged at least 2 hours before or the student(s) will be charged for the lesson. For semi-private lessons (2 students to 1 teacher), if one student needs to cancel and the other wants to proceed with the lesson, that student must purchase a private lesson for that day.

First-time registrants are entitled to a 10% discount on their first AFG class or tutoring package.

All students currently enrolled in a class or tutoring are entitled to all the benefits of AFG Membership.

Registration fees do not include the price of textbooks and exercise books, the prices for which vary based on the class and teacher.
